| Implant and crown. Expertly placed by our implantologist, Richard Anderson. | £2450 | |
| Adhesive/Maryland Bridge. Permanently glued to the neighbouring tooth or teeth. | £580 | |
| Metal partial denture. (Or chrome partial denture). Clips on to your natural teeth and is removed for your daily hygiene routine. This may be ideal where gaps outnumber your teeth or if your teeth are mobile. | £680 | |
| Fixed Bridge. Requires extensive preparation of the neighbouring teeth but is very robust and permanent (e.g. 3-tooth bridge £1698) | £566 per tooth* | |
| Acrylic partial denture. A removable, versatile, low cost option. | £290 | |
| Complete denture. These can be excellent if well designed - a great solution if your remaining teeth are very mobile. Can be secured with fixative or implants | Single £490 Set £850 | |
